Are you a Teaching Assistant working with deaf learners?

Do you provide technical support in a school, college or Local Authority?

Are you interested in learning more about the educational impact of hearing loss and how technology can help deaf learners communicate, participate and succeed?

To gain accreditation at BTEC Advanced Level, students are required to attend all six workshops and to successfully complete four units, each comprising supported self-study, workshops and assessed tasks. Students are also required to undertake a work placement of 5 days in one or more settings outside their normal workplace.
